Eligibility

To be eligible for the Berryman Scholarship, the student must meet the following criteria:

- A non-traditional student residing in Keith County pursuing a post-secondary education following a break in education OR
- A traditional student residing in Keith County continuing directly from high school to post-secondary education OR
- Be a student attending a public accredited college or degree-granting university to pursue a continuing education course, a degree or a certification program.
- The student will provide confirmation of enrollment and payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the school.
- Preference: A non-traditional student pursuing a post-secondary education

Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on your personal statement, leadership, service, academics, education goals and receipt of official high school, GED or college academic transcript.

Scholarship Deadline
