

Keith County Foundation Fund Berryman Scholarship Criteria and Application Form

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Berryman Scholarship, a student must be a Keith County resident and meet the following criteria:

- Be a non-traditional student pursuing a post-secondary education following a break in education OR
- Be a traditional student continuing directly from high school to post-secondary education OR
- Be a student who is attending a public accredited college or degree-granting university to pursue a continuing education course, degree or certification program.
- **Preference:** A non-traditional student pursuing a post-secondary education.

NOTE: Confirmation of enrollment will be required, and payment is made to the school.

Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on a personal statement, leadership, service, academics, education goals and receipt of official high school, GED or college academic transcript.

Scholarship Deadline

Completed application and official transcripts are required for consideration. Packet must be received via email or postmarked by June 1, 2025.
